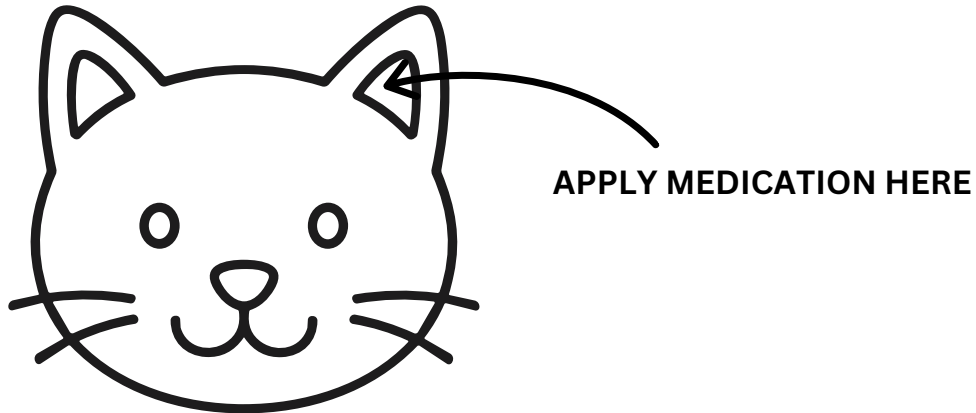


# PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

## Transdermal Cat Directions

Your veterinarian has prescribed your pet's medication in a transdermal base. This form allows the medicine to be adsorbed into the bloodstream through the skin of your pet's ear. Please follow the directions below. If you have any questions, please contact the pharmacy.



1. Wear a finger cot or gloves when applying the medication
2. Unscrew the cap on the pen device
3. Turn the base to the right to dispense the prescribed dose
4. Apply the prescribed amount onto your covered finger
5. Rub the medication into the front of your pet's ear, closer to the tip rather than in the canal
  - a. Apply to an area of skin with the least amount of fur
  - b. You may apply to one or both ears
6. Rub in thoroughly (like you would hand lotion)
7. Remove finger cot/gloves and wash hands
8. There may or may not be a thin film of powder left after the base dries
  - a. This depends on the medication
  - b. If there is a thin film - take a warm wash cloth and wipe off film before the next application
9. Store the prescription at room temperature. Avoid excess heat/cold.

**TOP BLACK LINE**  
Indicates how much medication is remaining



**APPLICATOR**

Medication will come out of here;  
Each turn/CLICK dispenses 0.05 mL

**BASE**  
Turn to the RIGHT



**CAP**

Screw on cap after each dose  
to prevent evaporation
